

Missouri Right to Life 2014 Key Votes Explanation Page for Veto Session

Vote Numbers Coincide w/2014 General Assembly Veto Session Scorecards

HB 2005, Section 5.165: Office of Administration Appropriation Bill that gives \$2,158,561 to the Alternatives to Abortion Program. This is an increase of \$525,000 from 2013. Missouri Right to Life strongly supports this program and increase in funding. The Governor vetoed \$500,000 of the increase. Missouri Right to Life supported overriding the Governor's veto.
(Final Status: Veto Overridden in support of the increase in Funding for A2A Program)

Votes Counted in Regards to HB 2005, Section 5.165:

House Vote: Number – 1

Senate Vote: Number – 1

HB 1132: Raises the Cap from \$2 million dollars to \$2 ½ million dollars on available tax credits for those who contribute to Pregnancy Resource Centers and Maternity Homes. This bill also includes tax credits for Food Pantries. The Governor vetoed this increase. Missouri Right to Life supported overriding the Governor's veto.

(Final Status: Veto Overridden in support of these important tax credit programs)

Votes Counted in Regards to HB 1132:

House Vote: Number - 2

Senate Vote: Number – 2

HB's 1307 & 1313: Extends the 24 Hour Reflection Period before an Abortion to 72 Hours. The Governor vetoed this protection for women and babies. Missouri Right to Life supported overriding the Governor's veto.

(Final Status: Veto Overridden in support of this important protection for women and babies.)

House Votes: Numbers – 3, 4
