<p>SB 1: Women’s Health Care Protection Act & Religious Protections not to be Forced to Participate in Abortion <i>(Final Status: Failed to Pass – However, Language was Amended on to SB 5 and ultimately was Passed in the HCS SS SB 5)</i></p>

<p>HCS SS SB 5: Women’s Health Care Protection Act & Religious Protections not to be Forced to Participate in Abortion. Language of the bill includes the following: requires annual abortion clinic inspections, requires complication plans for emergencies, prohibits interference with medical emergency vehicles and personnel, gives more oversight of abortion facilities to the Department of Health, increases ability of the Department of Health to create safety regulations, requires accountability and reporting for all baby body parts from abortion, and gives whistleblower protections to abortion clinic workers. Bill also grants the Attorney General concurrent original jurisdiction to enforce the state’s abortion laws. <i>(Final Status: House Committee Sub Passed (HCS SS SB 5) - Language was amended to include multiple related pro-life provisions)</i></p>
