RE: HB 1831 & SB 1058 - Legislation to Save Babies and Protect Women

Your action is critical to save babies and protect mothers!

Time is ticking away.....

We are in the final two weeks of the 2008 Legislative Session and there are only 8 days left for the Missouri Senate to pass legislation that will protect women from coerced abortions and offer her more information about her unborn child's development. HB 1831, or its Senate version SB 1058, is still waiting on action.

Missouri Right to Life members ask that you please take up and pass HB 1831 or SB 1058, the pro-life bill supported by numerous organizations and hundreds of thousands of pro-life Missourians, that will save babies and protect women

These bills simply require that abortion clinics offer an expectant mother an ultrasound so that she can see her baby's heartbeat, and require that she be informed about her child's development. These bills also address the outrage of coerced abortions - coercions like, losing an athletic scholarship or a job if a woman becomes pregnant and doesn't abort.

Please take the necessary measures to pass HB 1831 or SB 1058. Women deserve to be fully informed and protected from coercion.
