

Legislative Update – December 10, 2021

Pre-Filing of Legislation for 2022 Legislative Session

The 2022 Legislative Session will kick off at 12:00 noon on Wednesday, January 5, 2022.

Pre-filing of legislation for the 2022 session began Wednesday, December 1, 2021. At this time there have been 341 bills and 16 various resolutions filed in the Senate. And, there have been 474 bills and 35 various resolutions filed in the House.

Your Missouri Right to Life Legislative Team is working with legislators on pro-life bills to file for the 2022 legislative session. We have also begun reviewing all bills filed and will be reporting weekly in the lifelines during the legislative session. We will update you on bills that have either a positive or negative impact on our ability to protect innocent human lives at every stage of life and development.

Please read these updates. Your knowledge on these important life issues is important for when you speak with your legislators. Your involvement with your legislator is very important!

When we put out a legislative alert for phone calls, e-mails and letters to legislators you need to be ready. Your involvement is important to the passage of good solid pro-life legislation.

Bills to Watch:

NOTE: In the following lists Missouri Right to Life's position could change at any time depending on amendments that are needed or amendments that can happen at any point in the legislative process.

In the Missouri State Senate:

SB 637 – Sponsor: Bob Onder - Excludes from eligible MO HealthNet providers any abortion providers and affiliates **(Support)**

SB 639 – Sponsor: Pro-Abortion Jill Schupp - Modifies provisions relating to MO HealthNet services for pregnant and postpartum women **(Under Review)**

SB 667 – Sponsor: Eric Burlison - Modifies provisions relating to public funding of abortion facilities and affiliates and provisions relating to MO HealthNet providers **(Support)**

SB 688 – Sponsor: Pro-Abortion Brian Williams – Reauthorizes a tax credit for certain research expenses **(Under Review)**

SB 698 – Sponsor: Elaine Gannon - Modifies provisions relating to MO HealthNet services for pregnant and postpartum women **(Under Review)**

SB 699 – Sponsor: Mike Moon - Establishes the "Abolition of Abortion in Missouri Act" **(Under Review)**

SB 737 – Sponsor: Andrew Koenig - "Safeguarding All Children's Remains to Ensure Dignity Act" **(Support)**

SB 753 – Sponsor: Eric Burlison - Establishes the "Born Alive Abortion Survivors Protection Act" **(Support)**

SB 778 – Sponsor: Rick Brattin – Prohibits abortions following the detection of a fetal heartbeat and adds a private cause of action **(Support)**

SB 779 – Sponsor: Elaine Gannon - Modifies provisions relating to MO HealthNet providers **(Support)**

SJR 34 – Sponsor: Bill Eigel - Prohibits expenditures of public funds to any person or facility, or affiliate of such, performing or inducing an abortion **(Support)**

In the Missouri State House:

HB 1452 - Sponsor: Hardy Billington – Requires physician performing an abortion to perform ultrasound 72 hours before an abortion and explain the ultrasound and allow woman to hear heartbeat **(Support)**

HB 1461 – Sponsor: Adam Schnelting - Imposes certain restrictions on the expenditure of public funds for Family Planning **(Support)**

HB 1557 – Sponsor: David Gregory - Prohibits public financial benefits to abortion facilities or affiliates or associates **(Support)**

HB 1593 – Sponsor: Sara Walsh - Creates the "Born-Alive Abortion Survivors Protection Act" **(Support)**

HB 1636 – Sponsor: Brian Seitz - Increases the penalty for performing an abortion in the state of Missouri **(Support)**

HB 1741 – Sponsor: Shamed Dogan - Modifies provisions relating to contraceptives **(Under Review)**

HB 1752 – Sponsor: Chuck Basye - Changes provisions relating to instruction in human sexuality in schools **(Support)**

HB 1854 – Sponsor: Nick Schroer - Modifies provisions relating to health care **(Support)**

OPPOSE:

HB 1727 – Sponsor: Pro-Abortion Emily Weber – Would force a Pregnancy Resource Center (PRC) to Refer for Abortions and force the PRC to give Women False Information **(Oppose)**

HB 1868 – Sponsor: Pro-Abortion Emily Weber – Would Place in Statute Protection for the Right to Kill an Unborn Child **(Oppose)**
