Legislative Update – May 6, 2022 Legislation for 2022 Legislative Session

LEGISLATORS PASS STATE BUDGET

Following is the outcome of the House and Senate Conference Committees this week regarding pro-life budget items.

Pro-Life Budget Items:

HB 3007 – Department of Economic Development

1. 7.030 - Pro-life protective language on this line item for the Missouri Technology Corporation that no funds for research development can be used for human cloning or embryonic stem cell research or abortion services.

HB 3010 - Department of Mental Health and Department of Health and Senior Services

- Section 10.725 Family Planning Services and Healthcare Excludes Abortion and Abortion Services. \$11,571,927
 NOTE: This amount is \$2,000 less than last year.
- 10.576 & 10.956 Affirms that any clinic that performs abortion or provides abortion services is ineligible for public funding. Inserts a -0- dollar amount.
 NOTE: Planned Parenthood has filed a lawsuit against the state withholding money from them and the pro-life protective language.
- 3. 10.1110 In reference to 10.573 & 10.956 Pro-life protective language to ensure that clinics that perform abortion do not get public tax dollars.
- HB 3011 Department of Social Services
 - 11.160 Alternatives to Abortion Program (A2A) which includes funding for services to care for pregnant women. Program also includes a public awareness program and healthy marriage and fatherhood initiatives. \$11,158,561
 NOTE: Last year the amount for A2A was: \$8,958,561. This is an increase of: \$2,200,000.
 - 2. 11.760 MO Healthnet Pilot Program for postpartum care for up to 12 months after delivery to women with substance use disorders. \$750,000
 - 11.805 Show Me Healthy Babies Program. \$53,161,019
 NOTE: Last year the amount for Show-Me Healthy Babies was: \$60,296,982.
 - 4. 11.830 Affirms that any clinic that performs abortion or provides abortion services is ineligible for public funding. Inserts a -0- dollar amount.
 NOTE: Planned Parenthood has filed a lawsuit against the state withholding money from them and the pro-life protective language.
 - 5. 11.2030 In reference to 11.830 Pro-life protective language to ensure that clinics that perform abortion do not get public tax dollars.

CONGRESSIONAL MAP UPDATE

The map has not been completed. There was movement on a new House bill this week. The House Special Committee on Redistricting proposed a new map in HCS HB 2909.

Currently we are reviewing the map and we await what amendments the House will adopt next week that could change the newly proposed map. We will let you know what the final map means to pro-life Missourians.

Monday, May 9th begins the last week of the 2022 Legislative Session. The last day to pass bills for this session is Friday, May 13th at 6:00 p.m.

NOTE: The following list of legislation has been cut down to pro-life issues that are still pending in this last week. Missouri Right to Life's position could change at any time depending on amendments that are needed or amendments that can happen at any point in this last week.

SB 667 – Sponsor: Eric Burlison - Modifies provisions relating to public funding of abortion facilities and affiliates and provisions relating to MO HealthNet providers (**Support**) May 9, 2022 – On Senate Informal Calendar for Senate Bills for Perfection

SCS SB's 698 & 639 – Sponsor: Elaine Gannon & Pro-abortion Jill Schupp - Modifies provisions relating to MO HealthNet services for pregnant and postpartum (Support)
NOTE: Pilot Program placed in Dept. of Social Services Budget (\$750,000)
May 9, 2022 Bill on the Informal Calendar for Senate Bills for Perfection

SB 710 – Sponsor: Pro-abortion Doug Beck – Modifies provisions relating to healthcare **(Monitor)**

May 6, 2022 – HCS#2 to SB 710 in Conference

May 4, 2022 – Pro-life amendment (HB 2604) was placed as amendment on HCS #2 to SB 710

SB 723 – Sponsor: Dan Hegeman – Creates the "Medicaid Stabilization Fund" in the Missouri State Treasury. **Missouri Right to Life seeking pro-life amendment to prevent these funds from being used for abortion or to subsidize abortions.**

NOTE: The Anti-SLAPP language of SB 1219 and HB 2624 was amended on to SB 968 on May 3, 2022.

SB 1178 – Sponsor: Bill White – Modifies provisions relating to abortion, including the importation and distribution of drugs used to perform or induce abortions (**Support**) May 9, 2022 – On Senate Formal Calendar for Senate Bills for Perfection

SB 1219 – Sponsor: Elaine Gannon – Establishes the Uniform Public Expression Protection Act (UPEPA), which provides procedures for dismissal of causes of action based on public expression of free speech. Also known as "Anti-SLAPP" laws. SLAPP stands for "Strategic lawsuit against public participation". Anti-SLAPP would help to curtail frivolous lawsuits against people expressing their constitutional right to freedom of speech. (**Support**) May 5, 2022 – Amended on to HCS SS#2 SCS SB 968

SJR 52 & SJR 53– Sponsors: Andrew Koenig & Bob Onder – Establishes "Protect Children First" (Support)

HB 1897 – Sponsor: Bruce DeGroot – Establishes the "Correctional Center Nursery Program" in Correctional Facilities (Good Bill) April 27, 2022 – Executive Session Held – Voted Do Pass in the Senate Seniors, Families,

Veterans and Military Affairs Committee

HB 2009 – Sponsor: Suzie Pollock - Modifies provisions relating to immunizations – Protection of religious objections (Good Bill) April 26, 2022 – Placed Back on Formal Perfection Calendar

HCS HB 2012, as amended – Sponsor: Hannah Kelly – Ensures that no person (or abortion facility) shall knowingly donate or make an anatomical gift of the fetal organs or tissue resulting from an abortion to any person or entity for medical, scientific, experimental, therapeutic, or any other use (Support HCS HB 2012, as amended in the House – Support SCS) April 27, 2022 – Executive Session Held and SCS Voted Do Pass in Senate Seniors, Families, Veterans & Military Affairs Committee

HB 2604 – Sponsor: Jonathan Patterson – Modifies provisions relating to MO HealthNet services for pregnant and postpartum women (Support) May 4, 2022 – Placed as Amendment on HCS #2 to SB 710

HB 2624 – Sponsor: Chad Perkins - Establishes the Uniform Public Expression Protection Act (UPEPA), which provides procedures for dismissal of causes of action based on public expression of free speech. Also known as "Anti-SLAPP" laws. SLAPP stands for "Strategic lawsuit against public participation". Anti-SLAPP would help to curtail frivolous lawsuits against people expressing their constitutional right to freedom of speech. (Support) May 5, 2022 – Amended on to HCS SS#2 SCS SB 968

HB 2810 – Sponsor: Brian Seitz – Modifies provisions relating to abortion, including the importation and distribution of drugs used to perform or induce abortions (**Support**) May 2, 2022 – Placed Back on the House Formal Perfection Calendar

HB 2909 – Sponsor: Dan Shaul - Creates provisions for redistricting federal congressional seats according to the 2020 census (HB 2909 - Oppose). New Map (HCS HB 2909 – MRL Neutral) We (MRL) will be watching all House floor amendments on the New Map.

HJR 131 – Sponsor: Dan Shaul – Modifies constitutional provisions for voter eligibility and voting procedures (anti-ranked choice voting) (Monitor) April 14, 2022 – Second Read and Referred to Senate Local Government and Elections Committee

HJR 138 – Sponsor: Hannah Kelly – Proposes a constitutional amendment establishing the "Protect Children First" provision of the Constitution (Support) April 28, 2022 – Referred to House Ruled Committee on Administrative Oversight April 28, 2022 – Voted and Reported Do Pass in House Special Committee on Public Policy

OPPOSE:

HB 2117 – Sponsor: Dan Shaul - Creates provisions for redistricting federal congressional seats according to the 2020 census (Oppose – MRL Opposes any redrawing of a Congressional map that does not have a 7-1 drawing of districts. April 4, 2022 – House Message

March 31, 2022 – House Requests Senate Recede from its position and Grant the House a Conference. Vote is 131 yes to 17 no.
