Legislative Update – December 9, 2022 Pre-Filing of Legislation for 2023 Legislative Session

The 2023 Legislative Session will kick off at 12:00 noon on Wednesday, January 4, 2023.

Pre-filing of legislation for the 2023 session began Thursday, December 1, 2022. At this time there have been 374 bills and 30 various resolutions filed in the Missouri House. And, there have been 349 bills and 31 various resolutions filed in the Missouri Senate.

Your Missouri Right to Life Legislative Team is working with legislators on pro-life bills to file for the 2023 legislative session. We have also begun reviewing all bills filed and will be reporting weekly in the lifelines during the legislative session. We will update you on bills that have either a positive or negative impact on our ability to protect innocent human lives at every stage of life and development.

Please read these updates. Your knowledge on these important life issues is important for when you speak with your legislators. Your involvement with your legislator is very important!

When we put out a legislative alert for phone calls, e-mails and letters to legislators you need to be ready. Your involvement is important to the passage of good solid pro-life legislation.
