<b>HB 5:</b> Department of Administration Budget Bill. Moving of monies to expand Medicaid and possible expansion of abortion services. <i>(Final Status: Failed to Pass)</i>

<b>HB 76:</b> Provide Incubators for Safe Haven Drop-Off Locations for Newborns. <i>(Final Status: Passed on Separate Bill)</i>

<b>HB 430:</b> Omnibus Benevolent Tax Credit Bill. Bill was Heavily Focused on Adoption Tax Credits. An Increase of Tax Credits for Maternity Homes was Added to this Bill as it went through the Legislative Process. <i>(Final Status: Passed)</i>

<b>HB 1095: Increase in Maternity Home Tax Credits.</b> <i>(Final Status: Passed on Separate Bill)</i>

<b>SB 1: Renewal of Sunset Date on Federal Funding for Medicaid. Known as the Federal Reimbursement Allowance. Missouri Right to Life attempted a Pro-Life Amendment to Prevent our Tax Dollars from Being Used to Fund or Subsidize Abortion Providers.</b> <i>(Final Status: Pro-Life Amendment Failed to Pass. SB 1 Also Failed to Pass which led to a 2021 Special Session)</i>

<b>SB 43: Starts out as legislation to cover hearing aids in health benefit plans. Language for the Federal Reimbursement Act to ask the Biden Administration for permission to defund Planned Parenthood and abortion providers was amended on to the bill.</b> <i>(Final Status: Failed to Pass)</i>

<b>SB 101: “Safeguarding all Children’s Remains to Ensure Dignity Act”</b> <i>(Final Status: Failed to Pass)</i>

<b>SB 155:</b> Increase Maternity Home Tax Credits <i>(Final Status: Passed - Maternity Home Tax Credits were Added on to HB 430, the Omnibus Benevolent Tax Credit Bill. Bill was focused heavily on Adoption Tax Credits.)</i>

<b>SB 168:</b> “Born Alive Abortion Survivor’s Protection Act” would protect babies from being killed after birth. <i>(Final Status: Failed to Pass)</i>

<b>SB 398:</b> Prohibits expenditures of Public Funds for Abortion Services, Human Cloning and Prohibited Human Research. <i>(Final Status: Failed to Pass)</i>
