<p>SB's 45 & 90 and SB 106: Expands Number of Months of Care for Pregnant Women to 12 Months Post-Partum WITHOUT pro-life language. <i>(Final Status: Passed WITHOUT pro-life protective language that would have explained what "end of pregnancy" means. As passed, after an abortion care is included & paid by us.)</i></p>

<p>SB 133: Tax Deduction for Unborn Baby in the First Year After the Birth of the Baby. <i>(Final Status: Failed to Pass)</i></p>

<p>House Votes: House Votes were not counted because they were not clean votes. House added multiple other issues on this simple bill, which killed it when it was sent back to the Senate.</p>
<p>Senate Votes (Was a Simple One Issue Bill Before going to House): 2, 9, 10</p>
<p>SJR 8: Amendment to Prohibit Funding for Planned Parenthood <i>(Final Status: Failed to Pass)</i></p>

<p>SJR 28: Modifies Process for Approving Constitutional Amendments (Best Bill in the Legislative Session to Protect our Missouri Constitution) <i>(Final Status: Failed to Pass)</i></p>

<p>House Votes: NONE</p>
<p>Senate Votes: 3</p>
<p>HJR 43: Modifies Process for Approving Constitutional Amendments. Language was watered down in final version so that the bill only supported a small increase in percentage and did not include a requirement of a concurrent majority of 5 of the 8 Congressional Districts. <i>(Final Status: Failed to Pass)</i></p>
<p>Votes Counted in Regards to HJR 43:</p>
<p>House Votes: 1, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11</p>
<p>Senate Votes: 11</p>

HJR 19, HJR 24, HJR 25, HJR 30: Various Versions of resolutions to modify the process for approving Constitutional Amendments. These bills did not move through the process.
(Final Status: Failed to Pass)
